(LFF Stance) Bill - Author	Outcome	Description
✗ (O) HB1 - MCFARLAND	Sent to Gov.	State Budget - no additional funding for GATOR scholarships.
✗ (S) HB7 - M JOHNSON	Bill Failed	Prohibits expropriation of private property to support carbon dioxide transport and sequestration industry.
✓ (S) HB53 - FONTENOT	Signed by Gov. Act 48	Certain gambling crimes considered racketeering.
✓ (O) HB75 - JACKSON	Pending Gov. Sig.	Originally this bill carried a \$100 million loss of revenue from gambling. After opposition, the final bill is expected to result in a much lower loss of revenue for the state \$500K.
✓ (S) HB119 - FONTENOT	Pending Gov. Sig.	Penalties for creating fake pornographic images of others using artificial intelligence.
✓ (S) HB134 - SCHLEGEL	Sent to Gov.	Internet platforms which deliver material harmful to minors subject to civil fine.
✓ (O) HB146 - SCHAMERHORN	Bill Failed	Expansion of gambling in Sabine Parish.
✗ (S) HB190 - SCHLEGEL	Bill Failed	Duty of care in the development of software for interactive computer platforms.
✓ (S) HB192 - C OWEN	Passed Legislature Gov. Sig. not reqd.	Constitutional amendment prohibiting expropriation of property by a foreign adversary.
✓ (S) HB211 - VILLIO	Pending Gov. Sig.	Creates a specialty court system to deal with homelessness.
✓ (S) HB220 - SCHLEGEL	Signed by Gov. Act 535	Online platforms must provide method for users to report child exploitation and child sexual abuse material.
✓ (O) HB261 - BOYD	Bill Failed	Would have created exceptions to existing abortion laws.
✓ (S) HB288 - BOYER	Signed by Gov. Act 540	Provides for terminology for "miscarriage" in medical documentation.
✓ (O) HB293 - BOYD	Bill Failed	Would have added sexual orientation and gender identity as protected classes in employment under state law.
✓ (S) HB294 - FIRMENT	Signed by Gov. Act 148	"Stand your ground" protection for houses of worship.
✓ (O) HB373 - NEWELL	Bill Failed.	Legalization of recreational use of marijuana.
✓ (S) HB427 - SCHLEGEL	Signed by Gov. Act 552	Protecting children online.
✓ (S) HB476 - DICKERSON	Sent to Gov.	Requires public schools, grades 7-12, to post information about Louisiana's Safe Haven (for newborns) law.
✓ (S) HB568 - FIRMENT	Signed by Gov. Act 305	Enhanced penalty for using marijuana within 2,000 feet of a school zone.
✓ (S) HB575 - CARVER	Signed by Gov. Act 436	Surplus state vehicles for youths in the extended foster care program.
✓ (S) HB578 - M JOHNSON	Sent to Gov.	Changes "gender" to "biological sex" in state law.
✓ (O) HB611 - FREEMAN	Bill Failed.	Burdensome state regulation of pro-life pregnancy centers.
✓ (S) HB635 - HORTON	Signed Gov. Act 308	Penalties for criminal activity committed by an agent of a foreign adversary or a foreign terrorist organization.
✓ (S) HB690 - AMEDEE	Sent to Gov.	Foreign terrorists and adversaries cannot participate in the GATOR scholarship program.
✓ (S) HB691 - BEAULLIEU	Signed by Gov. Act 6	Integrity of voter registration.
✓ (S) HB749 - CARVER	Sent to Gov.	Online platform for managing education savings accounts.
✓ (S) HB816 - GALLE	Sent to Gov.	Prohibits foreign adversaries from acquiring or owning property near military installations.
✓ (S) HB883 - SCHLEGEL	Signed by Gov. Act 182	Prohibits online gambling, excluding state regulated sports and fantasy betting.
✓ (O) HB897 - M LANDRY	Bill Failed	Unnecessary legislation attacking crisis pregnancy centers.
✓ (O) HB931 - M LANDRY	Bill Failed	Attack on crisis pregnancy centers.
✓ (S) HB977 - BEAULLIEU	Signed by Gov. Act 185	App Store Accountability Act — protecting children on internet and in using applications on devices.
✓ (S) HB1137 - CREWS	Sent to Gov.	State employees cannot be compelled to use incorrect pronouns, names, or honorifics (titles).
✓ (O) HB1141 - T LANDRY JR	Bill Failed	Massive expansion of the commercial surrogacy industry in Louisiana.
✓ (S) HB1203 - EDMONSTON	Pending Gov. Sig.	School choice — Parent-driven learning microschools.

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✓ (S) HB1231 - BERAULT	Sent to Gov.	Medicaid coverage for pregnant women for glucose monitoring and for emergency dental treatment.
✓ (S) HB1253 - BUTLER	Sent to Gov.	Ethical treatment of human remains and organs following autopsy.
✓ (S) HCR26 - CHENEVERT	Passed Legislature Gov. Sig. not reqd.	Science of human growth and development in public schools at an age and grade appropriate level.
✓ (O) HCR71 - CHASSION	Bill Failed	Creates task force to study the availability of abortion drugs. Misleading insinuation that the drugs are not available for non-abortion related uses.
✓ (O) HCR111 - MARCELLE	Bill Failed	Task force to study legalization of marijuana for recreational use.
✓ (O) HR403 - T LANDRY, JR	Bill Failed	Task Force to study allowing massive expansion of the surrogacy industry in Louisiana.
✓ (S) SB29 - MCMATH	Sent to Gov.	Requires the autopsy report for any child under the age of nine who dies unexpectedly without explanation to include documentation of any immunizations administered to the child within 90 days of the child's death.
✓ (S) SB32 - MCMATH	Signed by Gov. Act 346	Establishes a Perinatal Bereavement Care Initiative within the LA Department of Health.
✓ (S) SB42 - EDMONDS	Sent to Gov.	Prohibits using artificial intelligence to create child sexual abuse materials.
✓ (S) SB87 - MIZELL	Signed by Gov. Act 205	Includes the production of child sexual abuse material in the definition of "commercial sexual activity" under human trafficking and child sexual trafficking.
✓ (S) SB110 - CLOUD	Signed by Gov Act 211	Prohibits using a child's image or likeness to train artificial intelligence systems to produce child sexual abuse material.
✓ (S) SB112 - HODGES	Signed by Gov Act 461	School Released Time Education Act - public school students can receive religious instruction off-site of school campus during school day.
✓ (O) SB119 - TALBOT	Bill Failed.	Gambling on the lottery over the internet.
✓ (S) SB152 - FESI	Sent to Gov.	No cell cultured animal tissue food product for human consumption.
✓ (S) SB199 - SEABAUGH	Signed by Gov Act 361	Mandatory minimum sentence for purchasing commercial sexual activity (prostitution).
✓ (S) SB200 - HODGES	Signed by Gov. Act 474	Protects land around military bases from ownership by foreign adversaries.
✓ SB251 - PRESSLY	Sent to Gov.	Provides mechanisms to protect against foreign adversaries accessing state-critical infrastructure.
✓ (S) SB252 - PRESSLY	Signed by Gov. Act 373	Provides clarity on consent for organ donation on driver's license.
✗ (S) SB269 - EDMONDS	Bill Failed.	Educating students on the "Success Sequence".
✓ (S) SB306 - EDMONDS	Signed by Gov. Act 379	Protects churches from unlawful intrusion and violence.
✓ (S) SB307 - EDMONDS	Signed by Gov. Act 487	Display of the Ten Commandments in a historical context on the grounds of the Louisiana Capitol.
✓ (S) SB310 - CLOUD	Signed by Gov. Act 259	Posting in public schools and colleges information on available pregnancy resources.
✓ (S) SB312 - TALBOT	Sent to Gov.	Teacher or other employee may stop his or her employer from deducting wages for the payment of union dues.
✓ (S) SB325 - REESE	Signed by Gov. Act 491	Excludes those who threaten violence from participating in sports betting.
✗ (S) SB354 - J - ANDREWS	Bill Failed.	Prohibits highly addictive "proposition" betting
✓ (S) SB427 - PRESSLY	Signed by Gov. Act 511	Ethical considerations with respect to organ donation.
✓ (S) SB435 - MYERS	Signed by Gov. Act 512	Creates the Louisiana Commission of Fatherhood Engagement within the office of the governor.
✓ (S) SB441 - MIZELL	Signed by Gov. Act 587	Seeks to protect the right of private secular and Christian Pre-K schools to operate without burdensome and unnecessary state regulations.
✓ (S) SB466 - SEABAUGH	Signed by Gov. Act 391	No expropriation of property by foreign power or corporation within 50 miles of a military base.
✓ (S) SB470 - MIZELL	Signed by Gov. Act 520	Provisions for pregnant women while in custody.
✓ (S) SCR37 - FESI	Passed Legislature Gov. Sig. not reqd.	Requests the surgeon general to develop a plan relative to informed consent for vaccinations.

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
